## Business

Alexa Wautier from the Thoreau Elementary PTO joined to talk about the Madison West Collaborative:

http://madisonwestcollaborative.com which provides food to families on the westside of Madison in need. 13 feeder schools are in Alexa's collaborative and provide donations and then volunteers provide anonymous delivery. In addition to food support and delivery, they provide rent assistance. Thoreau Elementary handles food support and Midvale Lincoln Elementary handles rent support.

They average about 325 families a week in food and delivery support. Cullen Haskins mentioned the rent support aspect is particularly appealing for the LaFollette Booster Club to consider.

The Lancer Secret Santa program was a resounding success this year. We were able to give gifts to 75 Lancers and 59 siblings this year. Mat Thompson read two letters of thanks from students who received gifts.

Scholarships: March 1st is the target date to decide on what amounts the Booster Club will offer. \$500 is the typical amount per scholarship.

Board of Visitors- Mat Thompson reported that the BOV is working with LAF social workers to give gift cards for clothing to students.

2021 Graduation: Mat Thompson reported there is a graduation working group of seniors who have met to begin planning the ceremony. Ideas floated include Kohl Center, Lussier Stadium,
